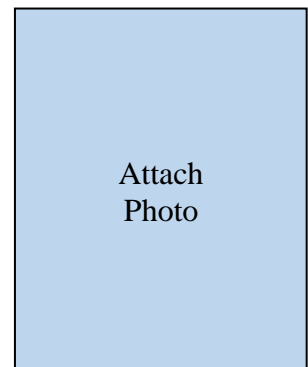

ALAMANCE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

Parental Agreement

ACS seeks to maintain a positive working relationship with parents and guardians. We desire parental involvement and partnership, which is so critical in our educational and Christian setting. ACS maintains that our educational objectives cannot be fully realized without the active interest, participation, and commitment of parents and guardians. Consequently, we expect our parents to be involved with teachers, staff, administrators, and to accept their part in educational accountability. We expect parents to support the educational efforts of our teachers, to closely monitor their child's schoolwork, to respond to communication from our faculty and administrators, and to praise and encourage their child in his/her efforts at school, to provide a place and time for study at home, and if their child needs extra help, to be that helper at home.

We recognize that there may be times when issues, differing views, or concerns may arise that need to be addressed. Problems not properly dealt with generally lead to greater conflict. Our administrators and faculty are available to meet with parents to discuss issues related to their child which they believe need to be addressed. We value communication, objectivity, and constructive dialogue that bring about solutions and resolution to concerns. In those sometimes inevitable situations, please be so kind as to express any concerns to the persons directly involved, such as teachers or administrators. Generally, it is unhelpful to communicate concerns to others that are not in a position to bring closure and resolution to your concerns. Notwithstanding, our expectations are that in the event of conflict or disagreement, parents and guardians will approach issues with our staff in a positive, objective, mature, and non-adversarial manner. Disagreements are not necessarily personal. And, if given the opportunity, our staff, in most cases, will be able to resolve your concerns.

Ultimately, we believe that our effectiveness as an educational institution is undermined when parents do not support our faculty and administrators. At what point a parent maintains a sustained lack of confidence in our faculty, staff, and administration, we believe that there exists a sufficient barrier to the positive and supportive working relationship that we desire. In the event of the deterioration of this positive working relationship due to an impasse which is seemingly beyond resolution, ACS reserves the right to deny a student from future enrollment at our school, and to begin the steps of transferring said student to another educational institution.

Alamance Christian School Continuous Enrollment Contract

Alamance Christian School is dedicated to making your enrollment process quick and easy. We are launching a new enrollment process called Continuous Enrollment that allows parents to enroll their students until graduation. Once you sign the Continuous Enrollment Contract, your student will be continuously enrolled until he or she graduates from ACS or until you Opt-Out of enrollment.

By signing this contract, you agree to the following:

- I/We agree that the term of my student's continuous enrollment begins with this signed Enrollment and Financial Terms and Conditions Agreement, and thereafter continues automatically through completion of grade 12 or, if necessary, until ACS receives official notice of withdrawal.
- I/We understand that the ACS Admissions Office must be notified by February 23rd each year of any changes in my plans of enrollment for my student.
- I/We understand that the Continuous Enrollment Fee will be billed to our FACTS account on February 1st of each year, and divided into three equal payments to be drafted on 3/5 (or 20), 4/5 (or 20), and 5/5 (or 20) to continue each subsequent year.
- I/We understand that if a family is not enrolled with FACTS Tuition Management, then the entire continuous enrollment fee per student is due by February 23rd of each year.
- I/We understand that families **NOT** planning to return to ACS must notify the School Office in writing by February 23rd of each year of their intent to **NOT** enroll for upcoming school year. Once written notification has been received of a family's intent to not return, the re-enrollment fee will be removed from their account.
- I/We understand that if notification of intent to **NOT** return is received after February 23rd of each year, the family will be contractual obligated to the entire enrollment fee per student for the coming school year.
- I/We understand that if a family's account is not current, they will not be automatically re-enrolled for the new school year. They will not be eligible to re-enroll until the account is brought to current and will go on a wait list for enrollment for the upcoming school year.
- I/We understand that the Continuous Enrollment Fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- I/We understand that if a family enrolled for the Upcoming School Year submits notice of withdrawal after:
 - **May 1st** -- They will be contractually obligated to an additional early withdrawal fee of \$100 per student.
 - **June 1st** -- They will be contractually obligated to an additional early withdrawal fee of \$125 per student.
 - **July 1st** -- They will be contractually obligated to 5% of their tuition for the **Upcoming** School Year.
 - **The 1st day of school**, they will be contractually obligated to pay all tuition through the end of the month of withdrawal as calculated based on a typical 10-month payment plan. In addition, a \$125.00/student early withdrawal fee will be assessed to their account.
- I/We understand that school records will not be released for any family with a balance due on their account. This includes any current school year fees, as well as, any fees for the upcoming school year.
- I/We understand that the continuous enrollment fee and early withdrawal fee may be waived under the following circumstances: (a) withdrawal of the student at the request of ACS, or (b) if there is some unforeseen circumstance that our Administration and Board of Directors approves.
