- 1. If accepted as a substitute teacher at ACS, you will be notified and placed on the call list.
- 2. When a substitute is needed, the office staff will call you and offer you a substitution job. We will call you in advance as much as we can. However, it may be on very short notice sometimes between 6:00 and 7:00 in the morning.
- 3. The teachers will leave you lesson plans to be followed that day. Do your best to get through the material on the list. If you run out of things for them to do, you may give them a reading or study time. You can pick up the plans from either the Administrator or the Principal. Check in at the office when you arrive for plans and a key.
- 4. Most of the time you will be giving assignments and overseeing students' work. Your main job is to keep order and keep them working on the assigned work.
- Dress for men is a collared shirt with dress pants. Women may wear modest pants and tops or skirts or dresses that come to the top of the knee. If uncertain ask the person calling you about appropriate dress. Tattoos/body piercings (except earrings for women) must be covered/removed.
- 6. Before you leave for the day, fill in a "Substitute" sheet at the office for our records and so we can issue you payment.
- 7. Pay for a substitute teacher is \$70 per day. Partial days will be paid according to the number of hours worked and position within the school.

- 2. What do you feel is the important function of the Christian school, and the distinctive characteristics of its educational practice?

- 6. Give your belief as to how the world and its inhabitants came into being.
- 7. What is your opinion of the Ecumenical Movement? Do you support the merging of denominations and religious groups into a commonly agreed one-church operation?
- 8. What is your opinion of Bible-based morality? Does it establish an absolute norm or will morality be relative to the individual and his environment?
- 9. What is your plan to insure that you will walk daily in the paths of righteousness?
