Choosing to include Alamance Christian School in your estate plan is a powerful way to ensure that your commitment to **Trusted Christian Education** continues for generations. As you begin this process, we encourage you to consider two primary areas:

1. What do you wish to give? Your legacy can take many forms beyond simple cash bequests. We are equipped to receive:

Suggested Legal Language

We recommend sharing the following language with your attorney to ensure your intent is clearly defined in your Will or Revocable Trust.

Specific Bequest

"I give, devise, and bequeath to **Alamance Christian School**, a non-profit corporation located in Graham, North Carolina, the sum of \$_____ [or _____ percent of my estate; or specific described property] to be used for its general exempt purposes."

Devise to Alamance Christian School (Broad/Flexible Use)

"I give, devise, and bequeath to **Alamance Christian School**, a non-profit corporation located in Graham, North Carolina, [insert percentage of estate, or description of property] to be used to further the school's mission of providing a **Trusted Christian Education**.

While this gift is intended to support the long-term sustainability and excellence of the school, it is my preference that these funds be utilized by the school's leadership to meet the most pressing needs of the **Warrior** community—including, but not limited to, capital improvements, student scholarships, or program enhancements—to ensure the continued development of students who will lead a **World Transformed for Christ**."

Residuary Bequest

"I give, devise, and bequeath all [or _____ percent] of the rest, residue, and remainder of my property, both real and personal, wherever situated, to **Alamance Christian School**, a non-profit corporation located in Graham, North Carolina, to be used for its general exempt purposes."
