Highlighting our Alumni

Jenn Wilkins Huon, class of '95, married Damson in 2009 and, 4 years later, began a ministry in Cambodia during 2014. They also adopted a child from China in 2018.

The goal is to enter unreached Cambodian villages with the gospel. Their non-profit, Cambodia Village Outreach, has a dual focus: "Evangelize. Disciple. Multiply." and "Transforming Villages. Impacting Lives for Christ." Currently, they work in 7 different villages with plans to continue to expand to surrounding villages by building a community center/church in 2026.

Weekly, they reach out to 400 children and disciple 50 adults. They leverage feeding programs, sponsoring children, and providing water filters. For everyone who receives a filter, they hear a clear presentation of the Gospel and it serves as a reminder that Jesus is the source of living water.

Thinking back on her time at ACS, she said: "ACS gave me a strong foundation in my faith that has carried me to today. I had so many teachers (especially Mrs. Rhoades) who inspired me to teach myself, which is how I was able to begin ministry in Cambodia."
