that we may gain a heart of wisdom.*

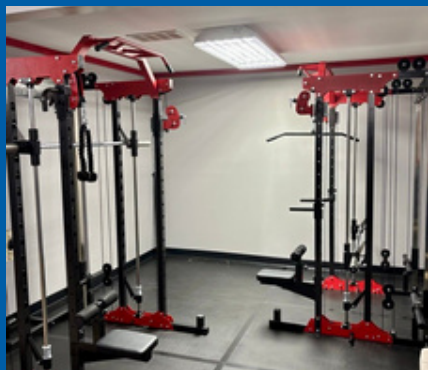
