Donations Record

The 2025-26 school year set several records from our four-peat in golf to the highest earned scholarships of more than \$1.6 million.

We can add one more record to that list as, for the first-time in history, we received over **\$205,000 in donations**. This figure included 8 gifts of more than \$10,000 and several transfers of appreciated stock to the school. Some of these gifts were anonymous, but the Lord knows who gave!

These gifts have helped the school complete smaller projects (e.g., LED lights in the gym, pre-K playground, new bus), so that funds can be saved for the building fund.

We are grateful for people who see ACS as a God-oriented ministry.
