## Highlighting our Alumni

Stacy Henning, class of 2015, currently serves with **Young Life** in Guatemala and has been there for 3 years. Prior to her time there, she also ministered in Costa Rica.

Her focus is evangelizing and discipling youth to see them become leaders of other newly saved youth. Their approach is to engage teens, provide food, share games, and share the Gospel.

Stacy recently spoke in chapel and shared a moving story. A young man that she helped lead to the Lord was tragically shot and passed away. She knew he was a Christian and is in the presence of Jesus, so, "the sacrifice of leaving her country and family is worth it."

In continuing chapel, she focused on Jeremiah 29:11 and the word prosper, peace, or good (depending on the translation). Its literal meaning is "a process of being made whole or complete by adding or subtracting." She mentioned a personal example - her father dying when she was only 13 - and that God, even then, had a plan and purpose in that challenging loss.

Thinking back on her time at Alamance, she said: "ACS, specifically speech class, prepared me to do what I do everyday in another country."
